**Footnotes**

COUNT ON LOU stalked the pace outside ROUGH ROAD AHEAD, was carried out by that one when taking command near the quarter pole, quickly opened up in midstretch and held sway while kept to his business. ROY L. circled the turn, was fanned wide near the quarter pole, gamely chased the winner through the stretch and was second best. ROUGH ROAD AHEAD, quickly clear, set the pace near the rail, drifted out entering the stretch then gave way in upper stretch. BOOT THE BOSS, wide on the turn, was floated to the six path near the quarter pole and was outrun. SAFE LANDING saved ground and steadily retreated through the stretch. OUR SECOND SLEW, outrun, swung to the five path near the quarter pole then lacked a response.
