WHO PLAYS BRAHMS chased the pace outside OUT FOR A STROLL, gained a short lead in midstretch and narrowly prevailed. STAR MONEY stalked the pace, advanced in the three path on the turn, bid for the lead in upper stretch and hung outside the winner. MY SWEET NENANA, a forward factor three wide on the turn, was steadied much of the final sixteenth of a mile, lacking room while full of run and closed the gap late. IRIS' PROVERB rushed up four wide on the turn, had aim on the lead entering the stretch and tired in the drive. SKIP THE NIGHT, in the two path on the turn, swung wide late and failed to be a factor. SAXY LADY saved ground on the turn, swung wide late and was no factor. BLAZING HONOR, outrun, swung wide in upper stretch. OUT FOR A STROLL sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and faltered in upper stretch.
