TAINT SO stumbled leaving the starting gate, rushed up outside horses to gain the lead approaching the half mile pole, set the pace outside POPPY'S PUNKIN, asserted himself in upper stretch and eagerly drew away while kept under pressure. JIMMYMAC BEAR, in close quarters between horses near the half mile pole, swung wide leaving the turn then rallied mildly. NORJAC, four wide leaving the backstretch, circled the turn, chased the pace through the stretch and weakened. POPPY'S PUNKIN had speed along the rail and weakened the final furlong. SWALLOW THE FIELD stalked the pace racing inside horses, angled out in midstretch and gave way. SUPER SHAPE (ARG) saved ground and was not a factor. CLASSIC WILDCAT, shuffled back entering the turn, raced wide around the bend and was outrun.
