Footnotes

DO SOMETHIN tracked the dueling leaders three wide, was asked to go on mid turn, asserted herself and took over entering the lane, drew clear past the three sixteenths marker, was kept alert with some right handed cracks near the sixteenth pole then held firm while taken in hand very late. RED'S ROUND TABLE stalked the pace two wide, moved to even terms after a quarter mile, dueled to upper stretch, could not match strides nearing the furlongs grounds but kept on well to be clearly second best. EXCLUSIVE WARRIOR , hustled along saving ground early, angled out around the turn, made some progress between foes in upper stretch, flattened out late but did manage to save the show. KALAMBAKA QUEEN dropped back after an alert start, circled four to five wide into the stretch then had belated interest. CRESpano , off the pace while saving ground, eased out past the three sixteenths marker then needed more between rivals. SUNLIT CITY was hustled clear after a furlong and secured the rail, was joined into the turn, dueled past the five sixteenths marker and weakened. MOUNTAIN ECHO failed to keep pace and faltered.
