EVEN IF lacked speed, moved up very wide leaving the turn, was in the six path entering the stretch, swept to the lead in midstretch then eagerly drew off while kept to her business. DANCE WITH JAMES circled the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch and was no match for the winner. MINETTA LANE , alertly angled to the rail entering the turn, saved ground and rallied. ALANA'S PRIDE , lightly steadied in traffic near the three eighths pole, swung wide leaving the turn and weakened through the stretch. CITI DISPUTE , two wide on the turn, swung out entering the stretch, was blocked inside the three sixteenths pole and failed to rally late. EX RATED LADY dueled two wide and gave way in upper stretch. SNOW ACE was outrun. WELL FANCY THAT had speed along the rail and faltered in upper stretch.
