Footnotes

TWIN CITIES , a bit rank leaving the starting gate, swung outside early, was wide around the turn, closed outside horses and drove clear. PRAIRIE TRIP stalked the pace, circled the turn three wide, challenged for the lead between horses near the sixteenth pole, finished gamely but was no match for the winner. CIRCULAR STREET , three wide around the turn, swung to the six path in midstretch and closed willingly. BETRAYED , in the two path most of the race, passed tired horses. SURRENDERTHEMONEY chased the pace three wide, gained the lead in upper stretch, remained on her left lead and faltered the final sixteenth of a mile. PRINCESS BEAU K , angled in early, hugged the rail and weakened in the drive. THREE WAYS HOME sped to the front, set the pace in the two path and faltered the final furlong. ALLEN'S LAST DANCE saved ground around the turn and gave way.
