Footnotes

HUMORISTIC was rated back off of rivals around the first turn, settled off the rail down the backstretch but was always well within range, moved up two wide into the stretch, found room between rivals near the sixteenth marker, closed determinedly under pressure and drew clear at the wire. RUNNIN UTE stalked the pace three wide, was put to urging around the final turn, raced five wide in the lane and continued willingly. ALL AMERICAN BLOND was steadied along between rivals in the opening half mile, moved up along the inside entering the stretch, angled out four wide in mid stretch, loomed boldly then flattened out. EMERALD N PEARLS set the pace along the inside, was joined entering the far turn, dueled from the three furlong marker to deep stretch and gave way grudgingly. PASS ME THE SALT prompted the pace two wide, lodged a bid into the far turn, dueled past the eighth pole then weakened late. WILD BEA saved ground in a forward position then dropped back leaving the three furlong marker.
