Footnotes

VENTURE EASTLYNE rated with the pace inside, kept in firm control into the turn, moved with the runner-up through the turn, dug in with a slight disadvantage from the top of the stretch but fought back determinedly to edge ahead the final sixteenth. LIGHTNIN DELIGHT rated off the early pace four wide, advanced to command into the turn, dueled with a slight advantage from the top of the stretch then grudgingly yielded toward the sixteenth pole. BETRAYED, a step slow at the start, broke inward and showed no early speed while well back off the rail then bid mildly to show. MISS ARMISTICE showed no speed inside and finished evenly. SOUTHERN DEVIL rated a slim lead two deep through the backstretch, gave chase on the turn and had nothing left in the stretch. BIPPITY BOP, awkward to break, gave chase off the rail, drew close three wide into the turn then quickly faded. RAZZLE AND ROAR and LYING WALDER were never factors.
