ROCK ON JUSTIN steadily advanced along the rail nearing the five eighths pole to prompt the pace, was lightly steadied leaving the far turn, angled out past the three eighths pole, rallied three wide between rivals approaching the stretch, gained command past the three sixteenths pole then edged away under a drive. SHIPWRECKSTREASURE drifted in at the break bumping IN THE JUICE, settled back early off the rail, rallied four wide to challenge nearing the lane, dueled outside the winner nearing mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. ADDUCE stalked the pace three wide, lodged a bid after a half mile, vied between rivals into the stretch then stayed on well for the show. ST JOHN'S GOSPEL, rated along early while close up, dropped back a bit near the three eighths pole, was ridden along two to three wide into the stretch then came up empty. IN THE JUICE, bumped at the break, raced within range early while off the rail, circled four wide into the lane but failed to respond. LOBO DEL NORTE, rated along between rivals early, failed to menace. LUCKY REAL LUCKY set the early pace two wide, was joined after a half mile, continued to battle to the quarter pole then tired.
