MY WILDEST DREAMS prompted the pace outside CAT WIESEL, disposed of that one in upper stretch and held sway under steady handling. MIDSUMMER'S EVE hugged the rail on the turn, eased out in upper stretch, advanced between horses to reach a striking position in midstretch then flattened out. FREDERICKA LA ROSE swung to the six path entering the stretch and rallied mildly. CENTRIPETAL MOTION, outrun to the turn, was fanned seven wide entering the stretch then passed tired foes. CAT WIESEL set a pressured pace along the rail and gave way in upper stretch. HATTA, four wide on the turn, gave way. WAKINA a forward factor in the two path between horses on the turn, gave way in upper stretch. STAR MONEY, steadied in traffic near the five eighths pole, saved ground on the turn, swung wide for the drive and was outrun. BASKETBALL BELLA, three wide on the turn, chased the pace to the stretch then faltered.
