Footnotes

TORCHRUNNER , away alertly, dueled early along the rail, shook clear under rating without much urging, nursed along on the lead to the five sixteenths marker, was confronted by two rivals nearing the quarter pole, lost command in upper stretch, battled back under solid right hand encouragement to regain command a sixteenth out then held firm. SKI POLE rated close up while saving ground, eased out mid way on the final turn, bid between rivals nearing the stretch, dueled between foes racing on his left lead and kept on gamely. CHAMBERS BAY , three wide both turns, moved up when prompted leaving the three eighths pole, gained a slim lead straightening for the wire, dueled outside the top pair while holding a slim margin past the eighth pole then faded in deep stretch. WITHOUT VIRTUE , towards the inside while off the pace, was pushed along racing inside a rival leaving the three eighths marker but failed to respond. PYRO CITY bobbled at the break, recovered and was sent up outside the winner around the first turn, dueled into the backstretch, was content to stalk leaving the five eighths marker, failed to respond when called upon leaving the far turn and faltered. SEA LORD , in range off the rail near the five eighths pole, came under pressure around the final turn, angled five wide in upper stretch and tired. MORAVITZ broke slowly, lagged off the early pace, was put to a ride nearing the half mile marker, failed to go on and faltered.
