Footnotes

LADY CASSANDRA , very rank and eager to go early on, rated back off of SKIT nearing the backstretch, settled into stride past the five furlong marker, cruised to the lead mid way on the final turn, opened a clear lead soon after, quickly widened in upper stretch, drifted out badly leaving the furlong marker, was shown the whip a few times and was geared down late. COMPADRE'S PEACH saved ground while allowed to settle, angled out three wide entering the lane and closed willingly. BLUEBIRD'S SONG lacked speed, came four wide for the drive and rallied mildly. SKIT cleared two wide around the first turn, angled in to set the pace, was overtaken leaving the three furlong marker, chased the winner to mid stretch then weakened. BOLD MEGHAN , between rivals leaving the far turn, angled in and weakened. PAPA'S PUMPKIN saved ground, raced forwardly for a half mile then tired. PAM AND GAYLA broke sharply, raced four wide the first turn, chased the leaders three wide into the far turn and faltered.
