Footnotes

THUNDER CHARM advanced to a short lead outside, drew clear toward the turn then steadily handled through the lane. LORD WILLING rated back off the rail, bid four wide nearing the five sixteenths pole and finished second best chasing the winner home. C FOUR settled well back inside, bid mildly angling out entering the lane, was shuffled back at the three sixteenths pole and finished evenly for show. DERWIN'S PEAK, unhurried about the three path, bid nearing the head of the lane then drifted inward five sixteenths away and flattened from there. EARLY NOTE rated just off the early pace and faded through the turn. APA, briefly with the pace from the outside, saved some ground through the turn and tired in the lane. JUST A LADY'S MAN was backed out of the gate to be re-shod, postponing the first race by twelve minutes, then through early. FOYLE hesitated a full length behind the field at the break.
