SHEELER stalked the pace three wide, lodged a bid in upper stretch, took command leaving the three sixteenths marker then edged away in the final furlong while under a solid drive. PRINCE KISSES bobbled and was bumped at the break, quickly assumed command, moved clear leaving the the five and a half furlong marker, set the pace inside, was collared in upper stretch, gave way grudgingly in the final furlong and saved the place. PERNAMBUCO was angled to the rail leaving the five eighths pole, stalked the pace inside around the turn, swung out in upper stretch but lacked a solid finish. CHANGING FUNDS was angled in soon after the break, settled, made a mild rail advance into the lane then came up empty through the drive. COPPER ROOSTER lost ground four wide, was urged along around the turn, made a mild run nearing the stretch then flattened out. SHAMELESS RISK , bumped at the break, saved ground mid turn but failed to menace. SKIP TO THE NORTH , three wide, chased the pace to the head of the lane then tired.
