RICO ENDS WELL broke sharply, rated close up along the inside, angled out nearing the lane, closed determinedly under left handed pressure and wore down HONEYMOON HARBOR in the final yards. HONEYMOON HARBOR prompted the pace two wide, moved to command mid way on the turn, drew well clear in mid stretch, gave way grudgingly and bled. SAINTTWOK was outrun early, angled out on the turn, came six wide for the drive and closed willingly. MAGGIE'S LAST CALL broke a step slow, settled off the rail down the backstretch, made a steady four wide run on the turn and into the lane, drifted out some in mid stretch then flattened out. KARAOKE DANCER chased the pace off the rail, angled in for the drive but lacked a solid bid. FRANKLIN'S MINT passed tired rivals. REVIVE chased the pace, came five wide for the drive and failed to respond. INFLATION saved ground into the turn and weakened. CASE LOAD, wide, weakened. MS LUCKY MANASTASH sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside, was headed mid way on the turn and tired.
