Footnotes

I WANT YOU TO KNOW stalked the pace two wide around the turn, drifted to the four path entering the stretch, swept to command in upper stretch, opened a clear advantage in midstretch and dug in tenaciously under urging to prevail. ROMP CITY bumped with BULAGA soon after the break, circled the turn five wide, floated to the seven path entering the stretch, advanced outside the winner, switched to his left lead near the sixteenth pole and closed to just miss. SILVER PRADO, four wide on the turn, was fanned six wide turning for home then finished evenly. GREEK THUNDER, between horses on the turn, was fanned to the five path entering the stretch, angled in near the three sixteenth pole and lacked the needed rally. POWER EMBLEM bumped with GO TO THE PULPIT leaving the starting gate, raced four wide on the turn and was outrun. WARRENSBURG, two wide most of the trip, was outrun. GO TO THE PULPIT bumped with POWER EMBLEM after stumbling at the break, saved ground on the turn and faltered. BULAGA bumped with RAOMP CITY soon after the break, ran off to a long, early lead, set the pace along the rail and stopped in upper stretch.
