### Footnotes

TYLERTON stalked the pace outside EMPRESS LISA, gained command approaching the eighth pole and drove clear. EMPRESS LISA sped to the front, set the pace in the two path around the turn and gave way grudgingly. PRIDE OF MAMBO circled the turn, raced wide entering the stretch and had a slight rally. SHE'SMINENOTYOURS, steadied in traffic near the half mile pole, stalked the pace three wide on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. OUT FOR A STROLL raced in the two path on the turn and was not a factor. AN TEALLACH saved ground and was done on the turn. APRIL'S DIXIE BELL, unhurried, raced in the three path and trailed.
