Footnotes

OUR NUMBER ONE broke a step slow, recovered and moved up between rivals under rating, swung out four wide nearing the quarter pole, closed determinedly under right handed pressure and forged clear of the dueling leaders in the final fifty yards. MAKULU MATATU sprinted to the early lead, dropped in entering the turn, took pressure past the three eighths pole, dueled inside LEAP OF WILL from the quarter pole past the sixteenth marker and stayed on well. LEAP OF WILL prompted the pace outside MAKULU MATATU, moved to challenge mid turn, dueled, gained a brief advantage in mid stretch, continued on gamely then stumbled in the gallop out. OPERATIVE was taken wide early, chased four wide around the turn, came five wide for the drive and steadily closed the gap. COLD SHOT , taken to rate early while saving ground, swung out wide leaving mid turn but had no response. WANNALOTTALOVIN' saved ground tracking the early pace and faltered.
