Six horses may be placed on the also-eligible list. Closed Saturday, February 17, 2001 with 16 nominations.

Footnotes

ELEKTRALINE angled to the rail soon after the start, rated close up, eased out for a clear run leaving the furlong marker, closed strongly under right handed pressure and wore down SILENT VALAY in the final fifty yards. SILENT VALAY set a pressured pace along the inside, shook clear nearing midstretch, drifted out a bit late and gave way grudgingly. PRIZED STAMP stalked a disputed pace three wide, was asked for run three furlongs out and came up empty in the drive. TIMELY AFFAIR lost ground four wide, stalked the issue to upper stretch and faded. END SWEEP'S GIRL pressed the pace two wide and gave way grudgingly. IT'S A TRUE RING raced between rivals into the turn and weakened. MISS CHEERS was rated back from between rivals leaving the gate, saved ground down the backstretch and lacked a response.
