### Footnotes

BALLADO ALERT prompted the pace outside CONCATENATION, dueled two wide between horses through the lane, and was up at the wire after his rider dropped his whip in deep stretch. DECOLATOR stalked the pace, eased out to the three path entering the stretch, gained a short lead near the sixteenth pole and hung. JOEL'S TOUCH stalked the pace, circled the turn, drifted wide near the quarter pole, had aim on the lead in midstretch then flattened out. CONCATENATION set the pace along the rail, remained prominent to midstretch then weakened late. TWO DRAGONS , sluggish leaving the starting gate, raced near the rail and was outrun. CAME EAST stumbled leaving the starting gate, raced well off the rail and was outrun.
