Footnotes

LEADHILLS took aim off of a contested early pace while three wide, edged closer mid turn, shifted out a bit wider for the drive, closed steadily under pressure, forged ahead nearing the sixteenth pole and pulled away. CROWDER was angled out mid turn picking up momentum, came three to four wide for the drive and continued on willingly to just get up for the place. BLUE MOUNTAIN CAT vied two to three wide under a rating hold, moved clear past the five sixteenths marker, widened a touch when shaken up in upper stretch, was confronted leaving the eighth pole then gave way grudgingly. MISUNDERESTIMATED stalked the pace towards the inside, eased out and moved between rivals entering the stretch but came up empty. DIVERSIFICATION failed to menace. ST. JOHNSWOOD dueled inside BLUE MOUNTAIN CAT, was put to a drive leaving the three eighths pole, failed to keep pace after a half mile then surrendered. WILHELM lagged far back, angled out six wide and failed to menace. SINGLE MALT MAC was four wide most of the way and failed to make an impact.
