Footnotes

HASTA LA PASTA , taken to rate three wide, moved to command in upper stretch, edged clear past the eighth pole then was fully extended to get a nose bob decision. SERENADIA , well placed inside off of a quick pace, advanced inside into the stretch, angled out four wide near the furlong marker, closed gamely under right handed urging and just missed. GOOD WILL broke a step slow, rushed up between rivals and moved clear nearing the five eighths pole, set a solid pace inside, was collared in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly through the final furlong. BEA LUCKY PLEASE was angled in early and lagged well back for five furlongs, raced inside in upper stretch and had some belated action. ALL AROUND bobbled at the break, lost ground three and four wide, had a mild gain leaving the three eighths pole then failed to respond in the drive. DEEP MYSTERY had speed along the inside, was rated back off of GOOD WILL leaving the five and a half furlong pole, eased out and stalked that one two wide, was ridden along mid turn and weakened.
