### Footnotes

PLEASANT HONOREE cleared early, set the pace along the inside, turned back a minor challenge in upper stretch, responded to solid left handed pressure and drew away while drifting out late. SALSIA GIRL, taken to rate while saving ground, eased out near the three eighths pole, lodged a mild three wide bid entering the lane, held well to mid stretch, gradually faded from there but did manage to hold on for the place. GRIM TEES GIRL, outrun early, saved ground into the lane and finished willingly. BERENGARIA was angled in early, made a mild run nearing the quarter pole, swung out wide for the drive, drifted out some in mid stretch then faded. COVE BAY, two to three wide, dropped back. FLYING WILDCAT chased the pace off the rail and faltered after five furlongs.
