Footnotes

HIT A HOMER , three wide around the turn, chased the pace outside BROADBROOK, overtook that one inside the sixteenth pole and drove clear. COHEED , wide on the turn, floated very wide in upper stretch and rallied steadily to gain the place. SEEKING THE POINT lacked speed, raced near the rail on the turn, angled out in midstretch and closed between horses. BROADBROOK sped to the front, set the pace in the two path on the turn, remained clear to midstretch then tired. FUNNY BOOK saved ground on the turn, eased out in upper stretch and closed the gap and was in tight quarters between horses at the wire. THUNDERING ON BY was not a factor. MAKUTUS saved ground, chased the pace for three furlongs, stopped and was eased.
