### Footnotes

EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH stalked the pace two deep, contested the turn for control nearing the quarter pole, dueled clear in the upper stretch and widened with steady handling through the final furlong. BANANA BOAT JOE lacked room while inside early, gave chase into the turn, eased three wide into the stretch then dueled for place. PILANESBERG advanced to the lead and rated the pace inside, contested the rail on the turn and continued a factor through the top of the stretch before yielding. BETH'S MARK showed no speed while off the rail, eased outward toward the quarter pole then leveled off widest. BLIZZARD BUSTER was outrun. ASK THE WIZARD chased the early pace inside but weakened after the opening quarter. RON'S PARTNER was never a factor.
