**Footnotes**

CINDER CONE stalked the pace while saving ground, got through along the rail to take a short lead in mid stretch, kicked clear inside the sixteenth marker then was fully extended to narrowly prevail. JANE'S KID settled towards the inside, gained some leaving the three eighths pole, swung out six wide entering the lane and finished gamely to just miss. BANK OF DAD settled in mid pack while off the rail, advanced four wide leaving the far turn, came five wide for the drive and finished gamely between rivals. DON'TTRYTHISATHOME bobbled at the break, recovered and was hustled to the front entering the first turn, set the pace towards the inside, raced off the rail into the lane, was headed in mid stretch and gave way grudgingly. SENIOR broke slowly, raced four wide into the first turn, moved closer three wide mid way down the backstretch, raced forwardly between rivals into the stretch, angled in and came up empty. A FLEET PROSPECTOR prompted the pace two to three wide and gave way in upper stretch. CORVO was steadied when in a bit tight at the break, saved ground and was outrun.
