Footnotes

BANDIDOS YANQUIS stalked the pace outside THREEANDDONEDAN, gained a short lead entering the stretch, dug in late and lasted. AVENUESOFNEWYORK circled the turn three wide, had aim on the lead in midstretch, challenged near the sixteenth pole then hung. OUR BAILIWICK , wide entering the stretch, closed the gap late. UNCLE TODD saved ground around the turn, eased out for the drive, advanced then flattened out. THREEANDDONEDAN sped to a clear, early lead, saved ground setting the pace, drifted off the rail entering the stretch and weakened late. HOWARD THE AVIATOR was outrun after stumbling badly at the break. KID KNOCKOUT , along the rail entering the stretch, was outrun.
