SUPERSTRUCTURE stumbled leaving the starting gate, advanced four wide between horses on the turn, took command under brisk urging in midstretch then drew off. CARIBOU KING , sent early, made the lead leaving the backstretch, hugged the rail, finished willingly but was no match for the winner. STORMING PAST circled the turn in the five path, drifted in approaching the eighth pole and failed to rally. ROCK prompted the pace outside CARIBOU KING and gave way in the drive. SANDRINO was outrun. ST. DADDY'S DAY chased the pace racing in the three path and broke down approaching the quarter pole. There was a stewards' inquiry concerning the run around the turn but no action was taken.
