Footnotes

VAN TASSEL set the pace, took the turn two wide, pulled away without encouragement and steadily drifted out the final furlong. GRAY DOWRY chased the pace outside the winner, weakened through the lane and held the place. TURINI saved ground and lacked the needed rally. JOHN FRANCIS , checked often and a bit rank between horses down the backstretch, swung wide on the turn and failed to rally. TANNENBAUM , two wide on the turn, was not a factor. TAPESPRIT , checked along the rail near the five eighths pole, swung three wide leaving the turn and failed to be a factor. BLITZBALL , four wide entering the turn, drifted in midway on the bend and faltered.
