**Footnotes**

STORM CATLILLY set a pressured early pace towards the rail, shook clear leaving the three eighths pole, repelled a threat from AVALANCHE ROCK soon after then drew away while kept to a solid drive. NIGHCUT dropped back off the early pace, angled wide, circled five wide into the stretch and finished willingly to earn the place. SPANISH WILDCAT saved ground early, lightly steadied off the heels of a tiring rival mid turn, altered out in mid stretch and finished with interest. GREEK DEFAULT steadied briefly in the early going, raced four and then three wide chasing the pace but failed to menace. AVALANCHE ROCK , three wide, gained mid turn to loom briefly, failed to sustain and faltered through the stretch. HUNTER'S HOLLOW prompted the pace outside the winner for nearly three furlongs then faltered.
