Footnotes

LOCHE , patiently handled down the backstretch, swung to the four path on the turn, took the lead outside CHARDSEY in midstretch then dug in stubbornly under brisk urging. CHARDSEY , four wide on the turn, bid for the lead between horses in upper stretch and finished gamely. IMORATAS lacked speed and closed between horses. WELL INTENTIONED , in the four path down the backstretch, angled in approaching the turn, saved ground around the bend, drifted wide in midstretch and faltered. KODIAK SONG advanced in the three path to gain the lead leaving the backstretch, raced near the rail on the turn and tired. SARBANES , no factor, drifted wide entering the stretch. KAY ONE dueled two wide and faltered on the turn. TRUE CHANGE dueled along the rail, faltered, bled and was eased.
