MERRYLAND MOON, three wide the first turn, stalked the pace, edged closer into the far turn, took over between runners mid way on the final turn, turned away SARAH'S KITTEN while drifting out into the lane, continued to drift despite right handed pressure and edged away. HONEST TRUTH saved ground early, angled out and advanced wide into the far turn, came four wide for the drive and finished willingly between rivals to gain the place. RIDETHESILVERTRAIN was checked and steadied along from the five and a half furlong marker to the five eighths pole, moved closer between rivals leaving the far turn, shifted in towards the rail and kept on with interest. SARAH'S KITTEN settled off the rail, steadily gained three wide into the far turn, bid to near even terns after six furlongs, was floated out by the winner when dueling into the stretch, failed to kick on and faded in the final furlong. NARITA stalked the pace, moved up after a half mile, chased two wide mid way on the final turn and faded. TINDERBOX cleared early, set the pace along the inside, took pressure three furlongs out, gave brief resistance then faltered in upper stretch. GOSPEL GIRL was extremely rank through the opening quarter mile, dropped well off the pace, was put to the whip leaving the far turn and failed to respond.
