Footnotes

PARADE OF COLORS stalked the pace, circled the far turn three wide, secured command in upper stretch and drew clear under steady urging. DELICATE GENIUS saved ground setting the pace and faded the final furlong. MISS ADDY KISS chased the pace outside DELICATE GENIUS and weakened through the stretch. NIGHTSWIMMING , well off the rail, raced evenly. CALOCAGATHIA , rank leaving the starting gate, circled rivals and passed tired ones. ANDRA , near the rail, chased the pace to the far turn then gave way in upper stretch. ARUBA was outrun. LIMEHEART , three wide on the turns, stopped and was eased.
