PERILOUS INDIAN saved ground off of a hotly contested pace, eased out two wide in upper stretch, rallied inside a rival leaving the eighth pole, kicked clear a sixteenth out and held firm under a drive. KENNESAW MOUNTAIN came away very slowly, saved ground into the turn and commenced a run under urging soon after, angled four wide into the lane, advanced on his left lead in mid stretch, kept on gamely but could not match strides. PELICAN COVE , away well, pulled his way up outside and engaged GATOR GOLD early on, dueled outside that rival under rating while putting up swift fractions, edged clear after a half mile, drifted a bit in upper stretch, was taken on from the inside leaving the eighth pole and faded. STAR DESTINY , three wide chasing the dueling leaders, was under strong encouragement mid turn, failed to kick in and weakened in the drive. GEORGETOWN BURNING , taken five wide early, failed to menace. GATOR GOLD dueled along the rail to mid turn, continued willingly to upper stretch then tired. TERRIFIC TRIO , lacked speed while removed from the inside, was put to the whip nearing the turn but had no response.
