Footnotes

ROCKY GAP , patiently handled, moved up four wide leaving the turn, closed steadily outside rivals and was along in time. BULLET CATCHER , unhurried early, advanced in the three path leaving the turn, challenged for the lead between horses near the sixteenth pole and just missed in a game effort. ELLIPSE sprinted to the early lead, angled to the rail leaving the backstretch, set the pace to the sixteenth pole and weakened late. FIELD PASS lacked speed, left the turn five deep and passed tired ones. WON THE WAR , four wide between horses turning for home, finished willingly. GOTOGO BYE , along the rail, chased the pace and gave way in upper stretch. THE MAN'S HOSS advanced in the three path entering the turn, chased the pace to upper stretch then weakened. ITZMIN , steadied in close quarters leaving the backstretch, chased the pace two wide on the turn and broke down entering the stretch. DOGWOODS BARTO lacked speed, raced near the rail on the turn and fell over the fallen ITZMIN in upper stretch. There was a stewards' inquiry concerning the spill but no action was taken.
