Footnotes

THE STORMY C prompted the pace four wide under rating, moved to challenge after a half mile, dropped back a touch leaving mid turn, chased the leader into the lane, came back under left handed pressure, moved to even terms a sixteenth out then was edging away at the wire. FERRY MUSIC , four wide early, angled in advancing mid turn, rallied along the rail to be on even terms with a sixteenth to go but failed to match strides in what was otherwise a solid effort. ASPEN BLUSH , four wide, steadily gained approaching the stretch, shifted out about a path wider for the final three sixteenths pole and kept on trying to the finish. HER ROYAL HONOR pulled her way to a clear early advantage, set a rated pace off the rail, met the initial challenge of the winner after a half, kicked back clear, came three wide for the drive, was confronted from both sides near the sixteenth marker and faded. WILL N' PAT settled back early, saved ground into the lane, shifted out past the three sixteenths marker but failed to generate a solid run. ANITA JOB , three to four wide, bumped with BOUDICCA near the three eighths pole, lugged in under right handed pressure in upper stretch and lacked a rally. BOUDICCA , towards the inside early chasing the pace, began getting out near the three eighths pole, bumped with ANITA JOB and gave way. SMART RULER , urged along inside into the turn, failed to keep pace and faltered.
