BOLD AFFAIR accelerated to the early lead, set the pace well off the rail, was set down in upper stretch and eagerly increased her advantage while kept to her business. BALTIMORE BELLE , bumped leaving the starting gate, lacked speed, swung wide mid way on the turn and rallied. MUSIC PLEASE , void of speed, raced in the five path on the turn and had a slight rally. HEAVEN'S VOICE , in the three path between horses leaving the turn, finished willingly. TERRA ROLLA , three wide on the turn, chased the winner and weakened in midstretch. SOUND IT OUT chased the pace two wide and gave way in upper stretch. LILY QUATORZE , along the rail leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the turn. ACCESS TO CHARLIE , bumped and forced out by ART OF THE HUNT leaving the starting gate, rushed up between horses mid way down the backstretch, angled to the rail entering the turn, chased the winner to upper stretch then faltered. ART OF THE HUNT bumped ACCESS TO CHARLIE when bearing out leaving the starting gate, was outrun and hugged the rail turning for home. OVERNIGHT FLING , wide entering the turn, was outrun.
