Footnotes

DASHIN' IDEA broke a step slow, lost ground four wide around the first turn and into the backstretch, drafted in a bit when advancing in hand past the five eighths pole, stalked the dueling leaders into the far turn, angled out and swept five wide to command in upper stretch, drifted in some when going clear in mid stretch then held sway under a drive. MINDTRIP settled in the two path, raced briefly between rivals past the five furlong marker, came five wide for the drive and closed willingly. MOUNT MOKHIEBA saved ground while taken to rate, continued inside through the lane and finished with interest. DEVIL DENIED disputed the pace between rivals, was ridden along leaving the three eighths pole, dropped back a bit near the quarter pole, shifted out past the eighth pole then finished up willingly. CONCEPTIONSREALITY , four wide around the first turn, prompted the pace three to four wide down the backstretch, moved to near even terms mid way on the final turn, forced the issue into the stretch then faded. FLYING WILDCAT , washy pre race, set a pressured pace along the inside, drifted out a bit entering the stretch then weakened in the final furlong. AIMING HIGH was outrun.
