BLUE EYED ANNA T saved ground stalking the pace, found room along the rail through the stretch, swept to command approaching the sixteenth pole then eagerly drew off under energetic urging. GOOD GIRLS DONT circled the turn, chased the pace, gained a short lead in midstretch, raced on her left lead and weakened. CRACKED ICE saved ground disputing the pace, drifted out a bit entering the stretch and weakened the final furlong. HAPPY SPIRIT , wide around the turn, faltered through the stretch. FAULTLESS JEN saved ground and was not a factor. OH PLEASE chased the pace three wide and faltered on the turn. AMAZIN QUEEN , fractious in the starting gate, raced very wide turning for home and stopped in upper stretch. MINETTA LANE dueled outside CRACKED ICE down the backstretch, remained prominent between horses to upper stretch, gave way in midstretch and was eased late.
