Footnotes

GOOD GENERAL cleared early, set the pace along the inside, was collared in upper stretch, dueled, dropped back to third inside the sixteenth marker, battled back under strong left handed pressure while on his left lead and regained command, regained command in the final yards and prevailed. IDOLATRY stalked the pace three wide, moved between rivals to challenge in upper stretch, dueled through the final furlong, battled gamely and just saved the place. MIDDLE BANK settled back off the rail, commenced his run leaving the half mile marker, circled six wide into the stretch and finished full of run. NO SHENANIGANS rated close up while saving ground, angled out mid turn, ranged up four wide into the stretch, bid to a short lead in mid stretch, dueled then hung between rivals. BRACE lacked speed, raced two wide into the lane and failed to menace. COWBOY GETS EVEN lagged far back off the rail, raced three wide into the lane and failed to respond. BANK OF DAD settled in mid pack, made a decent four to five wide run nearing the stretch, failed to sustain and weakened in the final quarter mile.
