Footnotes

FIFTY SEVEN G pulled himself to a clear early lead off the rail, was held in firm control through the turn, pressured into the lane and steadily encouraged to maintain. DOUBLE BIG GULP rated off the pace inside, closed on the rail toward the turn, was boxed on the heels of Fifty Seven G from the top of the stretch, eased outside that one near the sixteenth pole and finished evenly while dueling for place. POPPY'S PUNKIN rated off the pace about the three path, took aim three wide through the turn then outfinished in the duel for place. COINED FOR SUCCESS chased the pace inside, bid four wide near the quarter pole but flattened stride in the lane. SHAMSS showed no speed inside then no significant rally. JOEL'S TOUCH chased the pace four wide and had little left in the lane. PHANTASTIC PEACE stumbled losing his rider at the gate.
