SWEET GOODBYE prompted the pace outside LORI Z'S PUNCH, overtook that one approaching the three eighths pole, opened up in midstretch and held sway under steady urging. CALL OF A LION broke inward causing her rider to briefly lose his left iron, she worked between horses around the turn, remained on her left lead through the stretch and rallied gamely. ALL GIVING , off the rail, chased the pace, angled wide entering the stretch and gave way the final furlong. STERLING VOW saved ground, eased out two wide leaving the turn and was outrun. FASCINATIN' RHYTHM circled the turn, raced wide entering the stretch and gave way. LORI Z'S PUNCH had speed along the rail, stopped and was eased.
