BRIMSTONE ISLAND , away alertly, tracked the pace four wide, edged closer in hand nearing the quarter pole, collared FLYING POSSE straightening for the winner, dueled, poked a head in front in mid stretch, kept on under strong handling and narrowly proved best. FLYING POSSE moved clear early, set the pace under rating, entered the lane two wide while being confronted by the winner, dueled and just missed in a sharp effort. KEG rated forwardly while saving ground, came under a ride in upper stretch, remained a solid presence to the eighth pole, failed to go on and faded. NO BRAKES , between rivals off the pace leaving the three eighths pole, was under a ride into the stretch, swung out soon after and finished up with decent energy. PRAISEWORTHY , off the rail, edged closer after a half mile, angled four wide into the lane and faded. SAIGON STORY stalked the pace off the rail, made a slight move around the turn, chased into the stretch and gave way. FIJI BOY drifted in brushing with I'M SURE leaving the gate, was in tight soon after, raced off the rail and failed to menace. I'M SURE , brushed at the break, was outrun.
