Footnotes

SILVER BOLT rated close up while saving ground, eased out edging closer leaving the three eighths pole, bid to engage the leader after a half mile, responded when shaken up in upper stretch, kicked away soon after, was sharply roused in mid stretch, drifted in towards the rail and widened while ridden out. MIDIAN, nudged along chasing between rivals early, dropped back a bit leaving the far turn, angled three wide making headway into the stretch and continued willing pursuit to the wire. SUMMER TIME RANGER rated off the pace while off the inside, angled five wide in upper stretch and closed belatedly. MIZ MARZY moved up four wide in the opening furlong to gain a stalking spot, came under a ride trying to keep pace to the quarter pole, continued wide for the drive and faded. SLEWDIOUS broke a step slow and failed to menace. ONE MORE SON sprinted clear early, set the pace two wide, was taken on nearing the quarter pole, battled to the three sixteenths marker then succumbed.
