KARAOKE DANCER prompted the pace two wide, was pushed along some on the turn, took over in upper stretch then drew clear under a drive. SWEET TALKIN BABE was well placed towards the inside, angled out a bit in the lane and chased the winner home in willing fashion. SAINTTWOK saved ground while never far back, angled out in upper stretch but only had a mild rally. VINES OF JUSTICE lost ground and failed to respond. FAIR COUNT set the pace along the inside to the head of the lane then tired leaving the eighth pole. WEST IS WEST stalked the pace off the rail, was urged along on the turn and weakened. POLISH CHOICE was outrun.
