Footnotes

PENNIES APPEAL rated close up while four wide, moved to command in upper stretch, edged clear inside the furlong marker then was fully extended to prevail. MORE THAN A CRUISE settled back early but well within range, steadied off heels when advancing near the three eighths pole, regrouped and moved up two wide into the stretch, altered out to about the five path in mid stretch, closed gamely once straightened and was getting to the winner. HOW FAR WE'VE COME prompted the pace along the rail, eased back a bit to stalk around the turn, came back inside rivals leaving the eighth pole, drifted out late and finished gamely. MERRY LYNN broke outward, was corrected and set the pace under snug rating three wide, held a clear lead nearing the lane, was confronted by the winner in upper stretch, battled inside that one past the furlong grounds then weakened very late. ZAHARIAS stalked the pace between rivals, shifted in past the eighth pole and gave way. PROMISE ME was rated back soon after the break, circled the turn four to five wide and gave way. ORANGE'S LIL SIS chased the early pace inside and weakened.
