Footnotes

TENNIS RACKET stalked the pace, entered the stretch two wide between horses, challenged for the lead in upper stretch and held sway in an extended drive. EMPEDRADO, wide under urging mid turn, floated to the six path entering the stretch, bid for the lead in midstretch then flattened out between rivals. SINGING MY WAY saved ground, swung to the four path in midstretch and closed the gap late. ONE FRENCH KISS set a pressured pace along the rail and weakened the final furlong. OUR BAILIWICK, along the rail leaving the backstretch, eased out on the turn, floated to the seven path entering the stretch then passed tired rivals. ROCK N HEART, wide on the turn, floated to the five path entering the stretch then faltered. MONTY'S APPEAL chased the pace, was four deep entering the stretch and faltered. PERVIS prompted the pace two wide, drifted out entering the stretch and faltered.
