TRUSTEES GRAY secured the rail into the backstretch, set the pace in hand, turned back CHESAPEAKE CHARM in midstretch and was clear under a drive. CHESAPEAKE CHARM stalked the winner two wide, lodged a bid in midstretch, continued willingly but was outfinished. NO BLUES TONIGHT made a mild inside run into the far turn, was pushed along around the final turn and lacked a solid stretch response. FAIRLY WELL TUNED stalked the pace three wide and tired after six furlongs. T TIME MUSIC raced three wide around the first turn, settled in hand down the backstretch and failed to respond. PIN AND PECK raced three wide down the backstretch and dropped back after a half mile. NO PRESS BABY saved ground, was urged along down the backstretch and faltered.
