Footnotes

HURRICANE CREEK saved ground the first turn, eased off the rail entering the far turn, swung to the five path entering the stretch, took command under urging in midstretch then held off the inside challenger. CHANGING FUNDS , three wide the first turn, advanced in the four path leaving the far turn, bid for the lead between horses in midstretch, finished gamely but was second best. MY MAN DAN saved ground setting a pressured pace and gave way in midstretch. SILENT SHOT , three wide the first turn, saved ground around the far turn and was not a late factor. WORTHY WAGER , steadied in traffic entering the first turn, was two wide the far turn and gave way entering the stretch. PICS GOOD BOY prompted the pace two wide, drifted to the three path entering the stretch and faltered. OVECHKIN , steadied when pinched back soon after the break, was outrun. THE RED HAMMER was outrun.
