SHAMSS lacked speed, was very wide entering the stretch, closed steadily and narrowly prevailed. PHILHARMONIC bumped with SANDBAGIN' LOVER leaving the starting gate, saved ground to the stretch, angled out in midstretch, remained on his left lead and closed gamely between horses. SANDBAGIN' LOVER bumped with PHILHARMONIC leaving the starting gate, raced wide turning for home, had aim on the lead approaching the sixteenth pole then flattened out. STONE IN LOVE stalked the pace, circled the turn, bid for the lead near the eighth pole and weakened in the drive. YANO chased the pace two wide and gave way. SHOE FREAK MARLENE saved ground and was outrun. SIR SILVER FOX accelerated to the front, set the pace along the rail and gave way after five furlongs. FAST TALKING bobbled leaving the starting gate, raced outside horses, stopped and was eased.
